I. GENERAL INFORMATION

In order for this website to function properly and be able to provide the best products and services to site visitors, we place small data files on your device, called "cookies".

This policy provides you with information about these cookies and how to manage them.

II. WHAT IS "COOKIE"

Cookies are small files with text content and a unique number that are stored in the browser directory of your computer. They are created when you use your browser and on a web site that uses cookies.

Cookies help us to improve your experience when using the website, as well as to understand how people use our site and which of its pages are the most popular among its visitors.

Cookies usually contain little information such as the internet address of the website that created them, their validity and their number. Due to the small amount of information, they contain, cookies cannot usually be used to reveal your identity or personal information.

Cookies are often essential for websites that have large databases, require registration or use of a user profile, provide customization options, and more.

III. WHAT COOKIES WE USE IN OUR WEB SITE

1. Functional (necessary) cookies

These cookies are related to the proper functioning of our website. They cannot be deactivated. They do not collect information about you and cannot be used for marketing purposes.

The table below provides more information about this category of cookies:

Name	Duration	Description
lang	1 month	This cookie is used to store the language preferences of a user to serve up content in that stored language the next time user visit the website.
PHPSESSID	session	This cookie is native to PHP applications. The cookie is used to store and identify a users' unique session ID for the purpose of managing user session on the website. The cookie is a session cookies and is deleted when all the browser windows are closed.

IV. COOKIES FROM EXTERNAL SERVICE PROVIDERS

Usually, the origin of cookies corresponds to the name (domain) of the website on which they are located. This does not apply to cookies from external service providers. In them, cookies are created by the provider himself, who can be an advertiser, for example. These cookies collect information about your habits and interests on the Internet and can track you through various websites. Through them it is possible to determine which pages you visit, in what sequence and how long you stay in them. The most commonly used to analyze visits and consumers' interests in a while theme.

On our site, we don't use any third-party cookies.

V. HOW TO MANAGE THE COOKIES STORED IN YOUR DEVICE

Cookies can be disabled or removed with tools that are also available in most modern browsers.
